Police Officer Trustee & Fire Fighter Trustee Elections Call for Candidates

DPPF is seeking candidates to fill the Police Officer Trustee and Fire Fighter Trustee positions for a three-year term with no term limits beginning September 1, 2023.

The Police Officer Trustee and Fire Fighter Trustee positions must be held by a current or former City of Dallas Police Officer or Fire Fighter.

Texas law requires that all trustees, including the Police Officer and Fire Fighter Trustees, must have demonstrated financial, accounting, business, investment, budgeting, real estate or actuarial expertise. The Board will review applications to determine if the candidates meets the requirement.

Although, the positions can be held by a current or former member, Texas law dictates that only active members are eligible to vote in the Police Officer Trustee and Fire Fighter Trustee elections that corresponds with their role as either a Police Officer or Fire Fighter.
